ellenor Hospice is a specialist palliative care provider for adults and children in Dartford, Gravesham and Swanley, and for children across West Kent and the London Borough of Bexley. The organisation has in-patient and outpatient and Living Well services at Northfleet, comprehensive Hospice at Home services and a range of out-patient and community services all supported and delivered through a multi-disciplinary team.

Role Purpose

Reporting to the Senior Shop Manager, the postholder will assist in raising funds to meet our annual target by working with all members of ellenor's team and to ensure the smooth running of the shop. This will include the recruitment, training and supervision of volunteers, maintaining high levels of cleanliness and tidiness within the shop, sorting, pricing and displaying goods, serving customers and managing banking and returns in relation to shop. Supporting future plans and ambitions, Driving new ideas and growth in income generating to help the growth of the shop.

The duties outlined below are not definitive and may be changed in accordance with the needs of the organisation.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Recruit, motivate, train and support shop volunteers.
2. Maintain or exceed the minimum retail standards when sorting, pricing and displaying donated goods.
3. Manage the stock control for new goods and ensure all new goods are displayed to maintain or exceed minimum retail standards.

4. Manage stock levels daily to maximize sales.
5. Manage staff and volunteers to ensure the smooth running of the shop.
6. Prepare shop rota for staff and volunteers to ensure the shop is open as always advertised.
7. Serve customers, whilst setting high standards of courtesy and friendliness and ensure that your team is always friendly and helpful.
8. Monitor the shops progress against targets and take appropriate action in line with Hospice directives.
9. Maintain extraordinary levels of tidiness on the shop floor and in other shop areas.
10. Manage a safe working environment by following Health and Safety procedures and undergoing/delivering training as required.
11. Organise and execute retail cash operations procedures and day-to-day banking, ensuring necessary returns are sent to the Ellenor Hospices on time.
12. Attend regular Shop Managers meetings.
13. To represent the Ellenor Hospices within the local community.
14. Make yourself aware of what is going on at **ellenor** and act as an ambassador for the charity within the community.
15. Attend statutory and mandatory training sessions.
16. Any additional duties as reasonably required by Line Manager

Management and Professional Accountability

1. Demonstrate the ability to work effectively and reliably as part of **ellenor's** retail team.
2. Demonstrate the ability to manage own workload whilst prioritising and communicating effectively.
3. Recognise and work within budgetary constraints.
4. Ensure the economic use of resources.
5. Report any defects in equipment to the Senior Shop Manager
6. Be aware of and comply with all the Organisation's statutory policies and procedures as appropriate.
7. Provide accurate verbal and written reports as required.
8. Ensure safe working practices are maintained, with particular reference to the environment, equipment and vehicles.

Education, Training, Research and Personal Development

1. Participate in **ellenor's** appraisal system.
2. Identify own learning needs and participate in the planning, development and implementation of a personal development plan.
3. Attend mandatory training as requested.
4. Participate in in-service education programmes as appropriate.

General:

- Adapts and develops in line with the changing needs of the role,
- Acts as an ambassador for **ellenor** in order to raise the profile of the organisation at a local, regional and national level, as required,
- To maintain up to date mandatory and essential to role training
- Works flexibly across sites and departments from time to time as may be requested by their managers,
- Undertakes other duties commensurate with the seniority of the post as may be requested by their managers,
- To follow all policies and procedures,
- To be aware of the staff values of the ellenor and to behave as a fit representative.

Health and Safety

The post holder has responsibility to take reasonable care of self and others in relation to managing risk, health and safety and will be required to work within the appropriate policies and procedures.

This job description is not intended to be restrictive but is an outline of the main duties. The job description will be reviewed periodically to consider developments in the organisation, department or role.
