



PAYROLL GIVING & GIVE AS YOU EARN (GAYE)

What is Payroll Giving & GAYE?

Payroll giving is a scheme that enables employees to give to a charity straight from their gross salary (before tax is deducted).

How does it work?

The individual (who must be on PAYE) decides on the amount and the charity/charities that should receive it, and informs their payroll department who transfer this payment directly to the charity via a Payroll Giving Agency.

How much does it cost?

Because the donation is taken from your gross pay, every pound you give will only cost you 80p, or only 60p if you are a higher rate tax payer.
